## Step 2

## Cutting Instructions for Step 2

## Background Fabric:

Cut 2 strips ( $\mathbf{2}^{1} / 4^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF);
Sub-cut 1 strip into 4 ( $2^{1 / 4 "} \times 6$ ") strips, Reserve 1 strip,
Cut 1 strip ( $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF);
Sub-cut into 24 ( $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) squares.

## White Fabric:

Cut 1 strip ( $5^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF).
Cut 1 strip (4" x WOF).

## Dark Blue Fabric:

Cut 1 strip (8" x Width of Fabric (WOF));
Sub-cut into 4 ( $8^{\prime \prime} \times 8$ 8") squares.
Cut 1 strip ( $\mathbf{2}^{1 / 4 " ~ x ~ W O F) ; ~}$
Sub-cut into 4 ( $\mathbf{2}^{1 / 4 "} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strips.
Cut 1 strip (1-7/8" x WOF);
Sub-cut into 4 (1-7/8" x 21/4") strips.

## Medium Blue Fabric:

Cut 2 strips ( $2^{1 / 4 "}$ x WOF).

## Red \#1 Fabric:

Cut 1 strip ( 8 " x WOF);
Sub-cut into 4 ( 8 " $\mathbf{x}$ 8") squares.

## Piecing for Step 2

- Mark diagonal line on wrong side of squares. 4 Red \#1 Fabric 8" squares, 24 Background $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares, Reserve 8 for a later step.

- Make Half Square Triangles

Place a marked 8" Red \#1 square on top of an 8" Dark Blue square, RST. Stitch $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the marked line and cut apart on the line making 2 HSTs each time. In half of the HSTs, press the seam towards the Dark Blue. In the other half of the HSTs, press to the Red \#1 Fabric. Make a total of 8 HSTs. Label as Block D and square to $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.

(Make 8)

- Sew Dark Blue Point Pieces

Sew a marked $11 / 2$ " Background square on the
right-hand side of a $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2$ " Dark Blue strip, RST. Sew on the line and press the Background triangle away from the Dark Blue. Repeat with another Background square on the left-hand side. Make 4 and label as Unit 2-A.

(Make 4)

Repeat this process with a $1-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle of Dark Blue and 2 ( $11 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) Background squares. Make 4 of these.


Sew a $\mathbf{2 1}_{4} \mathbf{4}^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ " Background rectangle to the point end of this unit. Press the seam towards the Background rectangle. Make 4 and Label as Unit 2-B.

- Make Strip Sets

Sew a $\mathbf{2 ¹}_{1} \mathbf{y}^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF Medium Blue strip to a $53 / 4$ "x WOF White strip and press the seam to the Medium Blue. From this strip set cut 16 segments measuring $21 / 4$ " wide.


Sew a $\mathbf{2 1}^{1 / 4 "} \mathbf{x}$ WOF Medium Blue strip to a 4"x WOF White strip and press the seam to the Medium Blue. On the other side of the Medium Blue, add a $21 / 4$ " x WOF Background strip and press to the Medium Blue. From this strip set cut 16 segments measuring $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ wide.


Sew a section from each strip set with RST as pictured and press the seam in either direction. Make 16 of these and label as Unit 2-C.
