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## Step 2

## Cutting Instructions for Step 2

Background Fabric:
Cut 2 strips $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ by (WOF);
Sub-cut into 12 ( $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2$ ") squares.
Cut 7 strips 3 " by (WOF);
Sub-cut into 12 ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2$ ") strips and 44 ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ ") squares.

## Red

Cut 1 strip 3" by (WOF);
Sub-cut into 12 (3" x 3") squares; reserve 4 for use in Step 3, and 4 for use in Step 4.

## Piecing Instructions

- Add a $51 / 2$ " square of Background fabric on the left side of a Unit 1-G. Be sure that the lower left corner of Unit 1-G has Red fabric in it. Make 12 of these and label them as Unit 2-A. Press the seam towards the Background fabric.

(Make 12)
Unit 2-A
- On the wrong side of 44 Background fabric (3") squares, mark a diagonal line.

- Place a marked 3" square of Background fabric on the corner of a Unit 1-E that contains the Dark Blue fabric. Stitch from corner to corner on the marked line. Trim away the corner $1 / 4$ " away from the marked, stitched line. Press the seam open to complete the block. Make 44 of these and label them as Unit 2-B.


Unit 2-B

- Stitch a 3 " square of Red fabric to a ( 3 " $\times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip of Background fabric. Press the seam towards the Background Fabric. Make 4 of these and label them as Unit 2-C.

(Make 4)
Unit 2-C
- Stitch a 3 " square of Medium Blue fabric to a ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip of Background fabric. Press the seam towards the Background Fabric. Make 5 of these and label them as Unit 2-D.

(Make 5)

## QOV Mystery 1

- To a Unit 2-C, add a Unit 2-D, then another Unit 2-C, and finally a ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip of Background fabric. Press all the seams towards the Background fabric. Make just 1 of these and label it as Unit 2-E.

- To a Unit 2-D, add a Unit 2-C, then another Unit 2-D, and finally a ( 3 " $\times 101 /{ }^{\prime \prime \prime}$ ) strip of Background fabric. Press the seams towards the Background fabric. Make 2 of these and label them as Unit 2-F.
