## Cutting Instructions for Step 4

## Background Fabric:

Cut 3 strips 3" by (WOF);
Subcut into $2\left(3^{\prime \prime} \times 23^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips, and 4 ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ ) strips.

## Piecing Instructions

- Layout 2 of Unit 3-C with the top one the reverse of the bottom one as pictured below. Stitch them together. Press the seam to either direction. Make 4 of these Blocks. Label as Unit 4-A. The unit should measure $101 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$.

- Sew a 3" square of Red fabric (these were cut in Step 2) to a ( $\mathbf{3}^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 "}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip of Background fabric. Press the seams towards the Background fabric. Make 4 of these and label as Unit 4-B.


Unit 4-B

- Join 2 Unit 4-B on either end of a ( $\mathbf{3}^{\prime \prime} \times \mathbf{2 3}$ ") strip of Background fabric. The Red fabric should be the end used to join the pieces. Press the seams towards the Background fabric. Make 2 of these and label as Unit 4-C.

- Layout 1 of Unit 3-C with 1 Unit 2-A above it as pictured below. Stitch them together. Press the seam to either direction. Make 12 of these Blocks. Label as Unit 4-D. The unit should measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
