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## Step 3

## Cutting Instructions for Step 3

## Background Fabric:

Cut 3 strips $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ by WOF;
Sub-cut 2 ( $5^{11 / 2 "} \times 5^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) squares from 1 strip, Reserve the other 2 strips for creating a strip set.

## Gold

Cut 5 strips 3" by WOF;
Sub-cut 4 strips into 9 ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 \prime}$ ) strips,
36 ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3$ 3") squares.
Reserve the remaining strip for creating a strip set.

## Blue \#3

Cut 1 strips 3" by WOF;
Sub-cut into 4 ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ ) squares.

## Piecing

- Create a strip set by sewing a $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip of Background Fabric on either side of a 3" Gold strip. Press the seams towards Gold. Cut the strip set into 7 segments measuring $51 / 2$ inches in width.

- Create one more segment like those from the step above by sewing a $51 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of Background fabric on either side of a 3 " x $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strip of Gold. Press seam towards Gold.
- On either side of a Blue \#3 3" square add a $51 / 2$ " by 3" strip of Gold. Press seam towards Gold. Make 4 of these units.

(Make 4)
Unit 3-B
- On either side of a Unit 3-B, add a Unit 3-A. Press the seams towards the Unit 3-B. Make 4.

(Make 4)
Unit 3-C
- Cut each Unit 2-D and Unit 2-E in half cutting across the seam line of the half square triangles.


Cut Unit 2-D


Cut Unit 2-E

- Match one half of a split Unit 2-E with a split Unit 2-D as pictured below. Stitch on the diagonal seam and press to either side. Make 36 of these Unit 3-D. Trim this unit to a 3" square.

(Make 36)
Unit 3-D
- On the side of Unit 3-D containing the triangle of Gold, add a 3 " square of Gold. Press the seam towards the square. Make 36 of these Unit 3-E.

(Make 36)
Unit 3-E
- On either side of 18 Unit 3-E's, add a Unit 2-C. Press the seams towards the Unit 2-C on each side. Make 18 Unit 3-F.
