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Step 4

Cutting Instructions for Step 4

Background Fabric:


Cut 4 strip 3" by WOF; Sub-cut into 8 (3" x 3") squares, 24 (3" x 5½") strips. Cut 1 strip 3-5/8" by WOF; Sub-cut into 8 (3-5/8" x 3-5/8") squares.

Red Fabric:


Cut 1 strip 3" by WOF; Sub-cut into 9 (3" x 3") squares

Piecing

Add a Unit 3-E on either side of a 3" Red square.
Press the seams towards the Red square. Create a total of 9 of these Unit 4-A.



On either side of each Unit 4-A add a Unit 3-F.
Press seam towards Unit 3-F to complete the block.
The blocks should measure 13". Make 9 of these Units 4-B.



Unit 4-B (Make 9)


 Cut each of the 3-5/8" Background squares in half diagonally. Match a Background triangle with a Unit 2-G and stitch together on the long edge. Press the seam towards the Unit 2-G. Make 16 of these Unit 4-C. Square these units to 3", if necessary.

Unit 4-C

On the right side of the Unit 4-C pieces add a 3" x 5½" strip of Background fabric. Press the seam towards Unit 4-C. Make 16 of Unit 4-D.




On the left edge of 8 Unit 4-D add a **3**" square of Background. Press the seam towards Unit 4-D.

Make 8 of Unit 4-E.



Unit 4-E (Make 8)


On the right edge of each Unit 1-D add a Unit 4-E.
Press the seam towards Unit 1-D. Make 8 of these Unit 4-F.

On the left edge of the rest of the 8 Unit 4-D add a 3" x 5½" strip of Background. Press the seam towards Unit 4-D. Make 8 of Unit 4-G.
