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## Step 1

## Cutting Instructions for Step 1

## Background Fabric:

Cut 1 strip ( $5^{1 / 2 "} \times$ Width of Fabric (WOF));
Sub-cut into 4 ( $5^{112 " \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 ")}$ ) squares;
From leftovers, cut 16 ( $\mathbf{2}^{\left.11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 21 / 4^{\prime \prime}\right) \text { squares. }}$
Cut 2 strips ( 3 " x WOF);
Sub-cut into 8 ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 ")}$ ) strips.
Cut 1 strips ( $2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF);
Sub-cut into 4 ( $\mathbf{2 "}^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 ")}$ ) strips.
Light Blue Fabric:
Cut 2 strips ( 11 " x WOF");
Sub-cut into 4 ( $11^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ ) squares.
Save leftovers for later Steps.
Dark Blue Fabric:
Cut 2 strips ( 11 " $\mathbf{x}$ WOF");
Sub-cut into 4 ( $11^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ ) squares.
From leftovers, cut $\mathbf{4}\left(2^{1} 1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2 ")}\right.$ ) strips.

## Red Fabric:

Cut 3 strips ( $21 / 41$ x WOF);
Sub-cut into $4\left(2^{1 / 2 "} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ strips, $4\left(2^{1 / 4 "} \times 5^{1 / 2 "}\right)$ strips, 4 ( $21 / 4$ " $\times 71 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ ) strips.

## Piecing for Step 1

- Mark diagonal line on wrong side of squares.

4 Light Blue 11" squares.
16 Background 21/4" squares.


- Make 8 Half-Square Triangles (HST). Place a marked Light Blue 11" square on top of an 11" Dark Blue square with right sides together (RST). Stitch a $1 / 4$ " away from each side of the marked line and cut apart on the line making 2 HSTs each time. In half of the HSTs, press the seam towards the Dark Blue. In the other half of the HSTs, press to the Light Blue. Square them to $101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ and label as Unit 1-A.


Unit 1-A

(Make 8)

- Make 4 of these units.

Add a ( $\mathbf{2 1}^{1 / 4 "} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip of Red to one side of a $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of Background. Press seam to the Red. Label as Unit 1-B. $\square$ (Make 4)
Unit 1-B

- Add a ( $71 / 4$ " $\times 2{ }^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip of Red to an adjacent side of Unit 1-B. Press the seam towards the Red. Label as Unit 1-C. Make 4 of these.

- Make 4 Dark Blue \& 4 Red Pointed Strips. On both ends of a Dark Blue ( $2^{1 / 4} \mathbf{n}^{\prime \prime} \times 10^{1 / 2} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip, place a marked $21 / 4$ " Background square with the marked line going in opposite directions, as pictured. On each of the squares, stitch on the marked line and cut off the corners leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press to the colored fabric. Make 4.

- Repeat this process using Red ( $\mathbf{2 1}_{4} \mathbf{" 1}^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{1 0 1 / 2 " )}$ strips. Make 4.

- Make 4 and label as Unit 1-D. Join the Red and Blue strips with a (2" x 10112") strip of Background in between. Press the seams to the colored strips. On each side of these units add ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strips of Background. Press seams towards the colored fabrics. Square to $1 \mathbf{1 0}^{1} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$, if necessary.

(Make 4)
