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## Step 3

## Cutting Instructions for Step 3

## Background Fabric:

Cut 1 strip ( $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ Width of Fabric (WOF));
Sub-cut into 4 ( $\left.61 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares.
Cut 4 strips ( $3^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF);
Sub-cut into 4 ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 40^{1 / 2 ")}$ ) strips.
From leftovers, cut $8\left(2^{11 / 4 " ~} \times 2^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares.
Cut 2 strips (2" x WOF);
Sub-cut into 2 (2" x 401/2") strips.

## Medium Blue Fabric:

Cut 2 strips ( $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF);
Sub-cut 16 ( $3^{1 / 2 \prime \prime} \times 3^{11 / 2 ")}$ ) squares.

## Dark Blue Fabric:

Cut 2 strips ( $2^{1 / 4 " ~ x ~ W O F ") ; ~}$
Sub-cut into 2 ( $\mathbf{2 1}^{1 / 4 \prime} \times \mathbf{4 0 1} \mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime}$ ) strips.

## Red Fabric:

Cut 2 strips ( $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF);


## Piecing for Step 3

- Mark diagonal line on wrong side of squares. 8 Background $21 / 4$ " squares.

- Make 2 Dark Blue \& 2 Red Long Pointed Strips.
Place a marked $\mathbf{2 1 / 4 "}$ Background square on a Dark Blue ( $\mathbf{2}^{1 / 4 "} \mathbf{x} \mathbf{4 0 1} 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip with RST with the marked line going in opposite directions, as pictured. On each of the squares, stitch on the marked line and cut off the corners leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Press to the colored fabric.

 strips.
- Make 2 and label as Unit 3-A.

Join the Red and Blue strips with a ( $\mathbf{2 " ~}^{\prime \prime} \times 401 /{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ) strip of Background in between them with RST. Press the seams to the colored strips. On each side of these add ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 401 / 2$ ") strips of Background fabric. Press seams towards the colored fabrics. This should measure ( $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{x}$ 401/2"). Label as Unit 3-A.


- Mark diagonal line on wrong side of squares. 16 Medium Blue $3^{11 / 2 "}$ squares

- Make 4 Flying Geese at one time following the directions for the "No Waste Flying Geese Method":
Place 2 marked Medium Blue $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares on opposite corners of a $61 / 2$ " Background square with right sides together (RST). The smaller squares will overlap slightly in the center. Sew $1 / 4$ " on each side of the marked line and cut in half on the line. Fold the smaller triangles away from the Background triangle. Press the seam allowance towards the smaller triangles.

- Place 1 marked $\mathbf{3}^{1 / 2}$ " square of Medium Blue on the Background triangle corner with RST. Sew $1 / 4$ " on each side of the marked line and cut in half on the line. Press the seam towards the small triangle. Repeat with the other triangle unit; this creates 4 Flying Geese. Make 16 total and label them as Unit 3-B. Square these units to ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 ")}$ ), if necessary. Label as Unit 3-B.
