## Step 4

## Cutting Instructions for Step 4

## Background Fabric:

Cut 2 strips ( $51 / 2$ " x WOF);
Sub-cut into 8 ( $5^{1 / 2 " \prime} \times 5^{1 / 2 ")}$ ) squares.
Cut 2 strips ( $3^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF).

## Light Blue Fabric:

Cut 2 strips ( $51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF);
Sub-cut into 8 ( $5^{1 / 2 " \prime} \times 51 / 2$ ") squares.
Cut 2 strips ( 3 " x WOF).

## Medium Blue Fabric:

Cut 4 strips ( 3 " x WOF).

## Dark Blue Fabric:

Cut 2 strip ( $\mathbf{2}^{1 / 4 "}$ x WOF);
Sub-cut into $4\left(2^{11 / 4 "} \times 83 / 4 "\right)$ strips, 4 ( $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) strips.

## Piecing for Step 4

- Make 2 strip sets. Stitch a (3" x WOF) strip of Background to a ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF) strip of Medium Blue with RST. Make 2 of these and press the seams to the Medium Blue. Cut these strip sets into 16 (3" $\mathbf{x}$ $51 / 2 "$ ) sections and label these as Unit 4-A.

- Make 2 more strip sets.

Stitch a ( $3^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF) strip of Light Blue to a ( $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF) strip of Medium Blue with RST. Make 2 of these and press the seams to the Medium Blue. Cut these strip sets into 16 ( $3^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $5^{1 / 2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) sections and label these as Unit 4-B.

(Make 16)

Unit 4-B

- Make 16 4-patch units.

Place a Unit 4-A over a Unit 4-B with RST and stitch together. Press seams to the Medium Blue/Light Blue. Make 16 and label as Unit 4-C. This should measure $51 / 2$ " square.


Unit 4-C (Make 16)

- Add 2 more strips.

On the sides of Unit 2-D that contain the Red fabric and the Background fabric strips, add a ( $\mathbf{2 1}_{4}^{1 / 3} \times 8^{3 / 4}$ ") Dark Blue strip. Press to the Dark Blue fabric. Add a ( $2^{1 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) Dark Blue strip. Press to the Dark Blue fabric. Label as Unit 4-D. This should measure $101 / 2$ " square.


- Make 8 and label as Unit 4-E. Lay out 2 of Unit 4-C, 1 ( $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 51 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ )
Background square and 1 ( $51 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 51 / 2$ ") Light
Blue square as pictured below. With RST, sew together into 2 rows. Press to the $51 / 2$ "' squares in each row. Sew the 2 rows together. Press half of these units in one direction and the other half in the opposite direction. Trim to $101 / 2$ " square, if necessary, and label these as Unit 4-E.
