Step 2

Cutting Instructions for Step 2

Background Fabric:

Cut 1 strip (6¹/₂" x WOF); Sub-cut into 2 (6¹/₂" x 6¹/₂") squares. Cut 1 strip (6" x WOF); Sub-cut into 6 (6" x 6") squares.

Gold Fabric:

Cut 1 strip (6½" x WOF");

Sub-cut into 2 (6½" x 6½") squares.

Red Fabric:

Cut 3 strips (2" x WOF").

Dark Blue Fabric:

Cut 1 strip (6¹/₂" x WOF); Sub-cut into 4 (6¹/₂" x 6¹/₂") squares. Cut 1 strip (6" x WOF); Sub-cut into 6 (6" x 6") squares.

Piecing for Step 2

Mark diagonal line on wrong side of squares.
2 Background 6½" squares.



 Make Combination Units. Place a marked 6½" Background Square on top of a 6½" Gold square with RST. Sew ¼" on both sides of the center line and cut in half on the marked line creating two Half Square Triangles (HST). Make 4 HSTs total. Press the seams OPEN. Do not trim up these units.



(Make 4)

Center each of the HSTs on top of a **6**½" Dark Blue square. On the wrong side of each HST mark a diagonal line that crosses the seam allowance, going from corner to corner including the Dark Blue square.



Sew ¼" on both sides of the center line and cut in half on the marked line. This creates 2 Combination Units which are mirror images of one another. Create 8 units altogether (4 of each). Press the seam allowance OPEN and trim the units to 51/2" squares. Label as Unit 2-A and Unit 2-B.



NOTE: This process creates units that are "mirror images" of one another. This is correct!

 Create Background/Dark Blue Half-Square Triangles. Mark diagonal Line on the wrong side of 6" Background Squares.


6 Background 6" squares.



Place a marked Background **6**" square on top of a **6**" square of Dark Blue with RST. Stitch a ¼" away from each side of the marked line. Cut apart on the line to make **2** HSTs at a time. **Press the seams OPEN**. Make **12** HSTs; square them to **5**½". Label as Unit 2-C.



Create "Piano Key" strips. Sew 10 Unit 1-D together as pictured below to make a "Piano Key" strip. Make 2 of these strips measuring 501/2" each. If your strips don't exactly measure 501/2", you will have a chance to make adjustments later in Step 5.



Add Red Borders to "Piano Key" strips.
Sew 3 (2" x WOF) strips of Red fabric together with diagonal seams. From this long strip cut 2 strips equal to the length of the "Piano Key" strips. Add a Red fabric strip to the bottom of each "Piano Key" strip as pictured. Press the seam to the Red fabric. Label as Unit 2-D.
