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Step 4

Cutting Instructions for Step 4

Background Fabric:

Cut 1 strip (6" x WOF);

Sub-cut into 4 (6" x 6") squares.

Cut 2 strips (51/2" x WOF);

Sub-cut into 4 (5½" x 10½") rectangles.

Cut 1 strip (3" x WOF);

Sub-cut into 12 (3" x 3") squares.

Medium Blue Fabric:

Cut 1 strip (3" x WOF);


Sub-cut into 4 (3" x 3") squares.

Dark Blue Fabric:

1 (111/2" x 111/2") square saved from Step 3.

Piecing for Step 4

Complete 4-patch Block Units. Lay out a Unit 1-C, a Unit 2-C and 2 Unit 3-A as pictured below. Sew into 2 rows and press the seam in opposite directions between the rows. Sew the rows together and press the seam away from the 4-patch/HST row. If necessary, square to 10½". Make 4 of these and label as Unit 4-A.



• Complete some Star points. Sew a 3"
Background square on each end of a Unit 1-A.
Press the seams to the 3" squares. Make 4 of these and label as Unit 4-B.



Unit 4-B (Make 4)

Sew a **3**" Background square on one end of a Unit 1-A and a 3" Medium Blue square on the other end. Press the seams to the **3**" squares. Make **4** of these and label as Unit 4-C. **Note** the position of the Unit 1-A in this row. The points of the wing are pointing DOWN.




Unit 4-C (Make 4)

Mark diagonal line on wrong side of squares.


4 Background 6" squares.



• Create Large Flying Geese. Place 2 marked Background 6" Squares on opposite corners of an 11½" Dark Blue Square RST. The smaller squares will overlap slightly in the center. Sew ½" on each side of the marked line and cut in half on the line. Fold the smaller triangles away from the Dark Blue triangle. Press the seam allowance towards the smaller triangles.



Place 1 marked Background 6" square on the Dark Blue triangle corner with RST. Sew ¼" on each side of the marked line and cut in half on the marked line. Press the seam towards the small triangle on each half. Repeat with the other unit to create 2 Flying Geese. Make a total of 4 of the Large Flying Geese units. Square these to (5½" x 10½"), if necessary. Label as Unit 4-D.



• Add Background Rectangle. To the bottom of each of the Unit 4-D, add a 5½" x 10½" rectangle. Press the seam to the rectangle and label this as Unit 4-E.
