## QOV® 8 Mystery

This is a five-part mystery pattern designed to be used to create a Quilt of Valor®. In each part you will have some cutting instructions and some piecing instructions. In order to complete the quilt, you should have a basic knowledge of piecing and rotary cutting skills. Careful measuring, cutting, and piecing will ensure that you will be pleased with the finished product. Measuring and squaring up units as you go along (sizes are designated in the pattern and highlighted in yellow) will help to ensure a better product. Be sure to square up, if needed, whenever the pattern says to.

The fabric yardage requirements assume 40 " of usable fabric after removing the selvages from the fabric. If your fabric differs from this measurement, either more or less, you might need to adjust the amount of fabric you purchase. The fabric requirements given allow for a little extra fabric in case of errors in cutting or piecing.

NOTE: Instead of pressing to one side or the other, you will be requested to press some seams open. This is for ease in assembly later, noted by blue highlighting.

The fabrics shown below on the left are the ones that appear in the instructions and are meant to help you with the instructions. There is space in the right-hand column for you to add a small piece of your fabric for each choice - not necessary, but often helpful.

## In the Instructions

## Background Fabric: 2-5/8 yards

Light in color, white, off-white, tone-on-tone, but should read as a solid. This will be your background fabric.


## Light Blue: 1/3 yard

Light blue fabric; may have a small-scale print but it should read as a solid.


## Dark Blue: 1-1/4 yards

Dark blue fabric; this may have a small-scale print or something that reads as a solid. Part of this fabric is used as the outer border.


Medium Blue: 1-1/4 yard
Medium blue fabric; may have a small-scale print or something that reads as a solid. There should be good contrast between all of the Blues.

Red Fabric: 7/8 yard
A red fabric; something that reads as a solid.

## Special Fabric: 1/2 yard

This is a fabric of your choice and a good place to show off a special fabric. It just needs to look good next to your Dark Blue Choice.

Binding: 5/8 yard - NOTE - if you are binding in one of the fabrics shown above, add this amount to the that fabric's yardage.
