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## Step 2

## Cutting Instructions for Step 2

## Light Blue Fabric:

Cut 4 strips ( $2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF").

## Dark Blue Fabric:

Cut 4 strips (4" x WOF"),
Subcut into 32 (4" $\times 4$ ") squares.

## White Fabric:

Cut 2 strips ( $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF")
Subcut into $8\left(7^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares.
Cut 4 strips ( $\mathbf{2}^{\prime \prime} \mathbf{x}$ WOF").

## Piecing for Step 2

Create strip sets by stitching a 2" x WOF strip of White to a 2" x WOF strip of Light Blue. Press the seam towards the Light Blue fabric. Create 4 strip sets and cut them into $61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ segments. Label them as Unit 2-A. There should be 24 of these measuring $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.


Mark diagonal line on wrong side of 32 Dark Blue 4" squares.
Place marked Dark Blue 4" Squares on opposite corners of a $71 / 2$ " White Square with right sides together (RST). The smaller squares will overlap slightly in the center. Sew $1 / 4$ " on each side of the marked line and cut in half on the line. Fold the smaller triangles away from the Background triangle. Press the seam allowance towards the smaller triangles. Repeat this process 7 more times and label these as Unit 2-B.


Place 1 marked 4" square of Dark Blue on the Background triangle corner of Unit 2-B with RST. Sew $1 / 4$ " on each side of the marked line and cut in half on the line. Press the seam towards the small triangle on each half. Repeat with the other triangle unit to create 4 Flying Geese. Square these to ( $3^{11 / 2 "} \times 6{ }^{1 / 2 "}$ ).
Make a total of 32 Flying Geese and label them as Unit 2-C.
