## Cutting Instructions for Step 3

## Medium Blue Fabric:

Cut 6 strips (4" x WOF").

## Dark Blue Fabric:

Cut 6 strips (2" x WOF").

## White Fabric:

Cut 1 strip ( $6^{1 / 2 "}$ x WOF")
Sub-cut into 6 ( $\left.61 / 2 " \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares.
Cut 6 strips (2" x WOF").

## Piecing for Step 3

Sew a Unit 2-A on opposite sides of a $61 / 2$ " square of White fabric. Make sure that the Light Blue fabric is next to the center square. Press the seam to the outside. Make 6 of these and label them as Unit 3-A. These should measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$.


Create strip sets by sewing a 2" strip of White to a 4" strip of Medium Blue. Press the seam open. On the opposite side of the Medium Blue strip sew a" strip of Dark Blue and press the seam open. Make 6 of these and label them as Unit 3-B. This should measure 7" x WOF.

(Make 6)

Unit 3-B

Add Unit 1-A to Unit 3-B on the White fabric side of Unit 3-B. Press the seam open. Cut 2 of the strips sets into ( $121 / 2$ " $\times 361 / 2$ ") rectangles and label these as Unit 3-C. Cut 10 ( $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 ")}$ ) squares from the 4 remaining strip sets.

(Make 6)
Cut ( $121 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ) rectangles from 2 and label as Unit 3-C.

Cut $10\left(12^{1 / 2 "} \times 12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares from 4 strip sets.
