#### A five-part mystery quilt by Sandy Berg

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## Step 4

#### Cutting Instructions for Step 4

#### **Red Fabric:**

Cut 1 strip (3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF") Sub-cut into 4 (3<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6") rectangles.

#### White Fabric:

Cut 3 strips (3½" x WOF") Sub-cut into 32 (3½" x 3½") squares.

### Piecing for Step 4

Sew a  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " White square on each end of a Unit 2-C. Press the seams to the outside. Make **16** and label as Unit 4-A. They should measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".




Sew a Unit 1-B on each end of a Unit 2-A with the Medium Blue side against the Unit 2-A, as pictured. Press the seams to the inside. Make **12** of these and label them as **Unit 4-B**. They should measure **3**<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" **x 12**<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>".



Unit 4-B

Add a Unit 4-B to the top and bottom of Unit 3-A. Press the seam to the inside. This completes a Churn Block that should measure 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 12<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square. Make 6 of these and label as Unit 4-C.



(Make 6)

Sew a 3½" x 6" rectangle of Red fabric to each Unit 1-A2 that goes across both the White and Red fabrics of Unit 1-A2, as pictured. Press the seam allowance open and label as Unit 4-D. This should measure 6" x 6" square.
