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## Cutting Instructions for Step 2

## Background Fabric

Cut 1 strip (14" x Width of Fabric (WOF")), Sub-cut into 1 (14" x 14") squares.

## Red Fabric:

Cut 2 strip ( $31 / 2$ " x WOF"),
Sub-cut into 16 ( $31 / 2$ " $\times 31 / 2$ ") square.

## Pale Blue Fabric:

Cut 1 strip ( $151 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF"),
Sub-cut into 1 (14" $\times 14^{\prime \prime}$ ) square, and $2(71 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 ")$ squares. In the original posting of this step this line was in the instructions twice. The duplicate line was removed on 2/21/24

## Medium Blue Fabric:

From leftovers of Step 1,
Sub-cut into 2 ( $\left.71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ squares.

## Dark Blue Fabric:

Cut 1 strip ( $71 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF"),
Sub-cut into 4 ( $71 / 2$ " $\times 71 / 2 "$ ) squares.

## Piecing for Step 2

1 - Sew a Unit 1C on 2 opposite sides of a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Red fabric square and press seams. Create 16 of these and trim to $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$. Label as Unit 2A.


Unit 2A
2 -Begin with a $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of Pale Blue and a $71 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square of Medium Blue fabrics. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of one square and place the squares right sides together. Stitch $1 / 4$ " on each side of the marked line and cut apart on the marked line to create 2 HSTs and press the seams open. Mark a diagonal line on the wrong side of each HST that crosses the seam line. Label as Unit 2B. Do not trim these.


3 - Lay each Unit 2B on top of a $71 / 2$ " square of Dark Blue with right sides together (RST). Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on both sides of the marked diagonal line and cut on the line. Press the seams open. Trim to $61 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Label as Unit 2C.

4 - Create 8 Half Square Triangles (HST) using the included "HSTs - 8 at a time". Starting squares will be 14 " squares of Pale Blue and the Background fabrics. Trim the 8 HSTs to $61 / 2 " \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares. Label as Unit 2D.
