

# QOV Mystery 9

A five-part mystery quilt by **Sandy Berg**

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## Step 3

### Cutting Instructions for Step 3

**Press seams open unless otherwise specified.**

#### Background Fabric:

- From the leftovers from Step 1
- Sub-cut into **2 (7" x 7")** squares,
- Cut **4 strips (2" x WOF)**,
- Sub-cut into **64 (2" x 2")** squares.

#### Pale Blue Fabric:

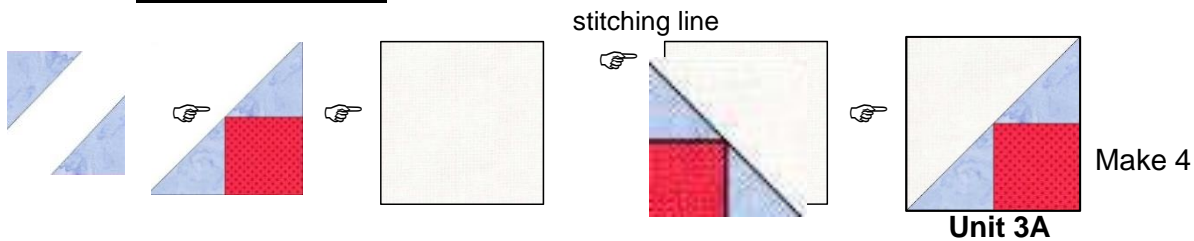
- Cut **1 strip (4" x WOF)**,
- Sub-cut into **4 (4" x 4")** squares.

#### Red Fabric:

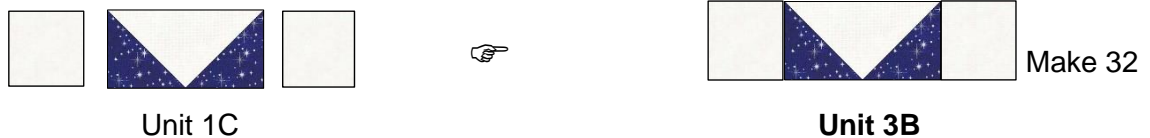
- Cut **1 strips (3½" x WOF)**,
- Sub-cut into **4 (3½" x 3½")** squares.

### Piecing for Step 3

1 – Cut **4 (4")** Pale Blue fabric squares in half diagonally. Cut the **7"** Background fabric squares in half diagonally. Stitch the Pale Blue triangles on adjacent sides of the Red fabric square and press. Lay one of the Background triangles on top of unit with RST and stitch. Press the seams and label as Unit 3A. Makes 4 of these units and **trim to 6½" x 6½"**.



2 – Stitch a **2"** square of Background fabric on each end of all of the remaining Unit 1C. Press the seam and mark as Unit 3B. Make 32 of these and **trim to 2" x 6½"**.



3 – Stitch a Unit 3B on each side of a Unit 2A. Press the seam and label as Unit 3C. There will be **16 stars** measuring **6½" x 6½"**.
